

Job Title: Assistant Professor - Psychology (Clinical)

The Department of Psychology at the University of Cincinnati (UC) seeks to hire a tenure-track Assistant Professor in clinical psychology who will contribute to the department's research, undergraduate and graduate teaching, and service missions. The minimum qualifications for this position include completion of a Ph.D. in Psychology from an APA-accredited program, completion of an APA accredited internship, and license eligibility as a psychologist in Ohio.

The ideal applicant will have an established publication record and ability to secure external funding in a programmatic area of research. We welcome applicants with research interests in a variety of clinically relevant areas, but are particularly interested in candidates whose research is relevant to community health; health or mental health disparities; substance abuse; or pediatric psychology. This position affords opportunities to collaborate with the University of Cincinnati's College of Medicine, Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center, and local community agencies. The successful candidate will be expected to conduct research, mentor student research, provide clinical supervision of doctoral students in our department's Behavioral Health Center, teach at the undergraduate and graduate levels, and make service contributions to the department, the university, and the profession.

Qualified applicants will be evaluated on

- Training and experience in clinical psychology
- Their program of research, including publication record and ability to obtain extramural funding
- Their potential to provide high-quality clinical supervision
- Record of teaching excellence

We strongly encourage applications from members of under-represented groups, including people of color, persons with disabilities, and veterans. The University is especially interested in qualified candidates who can contribute, through their research, teaching, or service, to the diversity and excellence of the academic community in general, and to the department and clinical program in particular, and who can contribute to the lessening of disparities in health care access and outcomes in the community at large. We seek applicants who can teach in a diverse university community and have experience helping students from diverse backgrounds succeed. UC and the Department of Psychology are responsive to candidates' work-life concerns and are committed to building a multicultural work force. Applicants must include with the online application a current curriculum vitae and a cover letter not to exceed three pages that includes a description of: (a) research interests, (b) teaching experiences, (c) experiences to support an ability to provide clinical supervision, including a description of readiness to apply for Ohio licensure as a Psychologist, and (d) the names, titles, addresses, phone numbers, and email addresses of at least three but no more than five professional references. In addition, you will be asked to upload a separate one-page statement describing your commitment to diversity.
