Graduation Requirements

- All requirements for the doctoral degree must be completed within nine consecutive years of the date of matriculation into the program (up to five years pre-candidacy and four years post-candidacy). Term admitted to Program: _____
- Residency requirement: 10 graduate credit hours (12 if funded by a GA) per semester for four out of five consecutive semesters of study (including summer) or three consecutive summer semesters.
- Accumulated GPA of 3.0 or higher _____
- Removal of all **I** and **NG** grades, and satisfactory repetition or waiver of all **F** grades. Assignment of letter grade to final course in any series of courses graded **UP/SP**.
- o To maintain active status, students must be enrolled for at least one graduate credit hour each semester.
- The doctoral degree requires a minimum of three years of full-time graduate study in the student's degree program and either a minimum of 90 graduate credits beyond the bachelor's degree or a minimum of 60 credits beyond a master's degree, including at least 7 hours in dissertation research.
