

Exam Areas and Committees: PhD in Literary and Cultural Studies

Students will develop two areas of study with two different faculty members, at least one of which must have a significant theoretical component. A third examiner, in addition to serving as moderator, will be a full member of the committee and respond to exams as a whole.

Students must have committees formed by the beginning of the second semester of their second year of study and approval of their areas and their lists from their exam committee and the DGS by the end of the second year of study. Exams must be completed by February 15 of the third year of study.
