A minor requires 21 credit hours in Asian Studies courses, including at least 12 credits in non-language courses (this simply means that no more than 10 credits of language courses would count for the minor). Two standard ways to get the minor are:

- a) 10 credits in language courses (eg., from Chinese / Japanese 1001-1002-2001-2002, or Japn/Chin 1011-12-13-14) and 12 credits in non-language courses;
- or b) 21 credits in non-language courses (i.e. no language classes).

For the non-language courses, it is recommended that students take:

- 6 credits / two classes in social sciences (anthropology, economics, geography, planning/environment/urban studies, political science, sociology).
- 6 credits / two classes in humanities (art history, culture, literature, history, music, philosophy, religion, WGSS, Asian Studies, languages).
- A regional breadth of at least one class covering East/Southeast Asia (China, Japan, and nearby countries) and one on South/Southwest Asia (India, nearby countries, Central Asia, and West Asia).
