The Judaic Studies Major consists of 39 – 41 credit hours and prepares students for further academic work in Judaic studies, Near and Middle Eastern studies, religious studies, Holocaust studies and other related fields. A Judaic studies degree also prepares one for careers in research and in various private- and public- sector fields. The Hebrew Concentration enables students to demonstrate linguistic competency to future employers and graduate schools that require either proficiency in a foreign language in general, or specifically Hebrew.
