

## **Certificate in Experiential Leadership in the Outdoors**

### **Description:**

The certificate in experiential leadership in the outdoors combines core coursework in the various functional areas of leadership with elective courses that enable students to sample a variety of topics relating to real-world, experiential topics. The objective of the certificate is to provide a fundamental understanding of experiential leadership and engage students in hands-on learning.
