

Spend summer 2023 in Bordeaux!

Enroll in the 2023 summer program at Université Bordeaux Montaigne in the DEFLE program! The program will take place July 3-21, 2023 (tentative dates).

DEFLE (Département d'Études de Français Langue Étrangère) is an immersive, language and cultural program located near Bordeaux, in southwest France.

The summer program is great for students who will have completed FREN 1014, FREN 1002, FREN 2015, or FREN 2016 spring 2023 with a grade of B- or higher. It is also ideal for students who will have completed either FREN 3001 fall 2022 or FREN 3002 spring 2023 with a grade of B- or higher (just one of the two courses).

Earn up to six credits: three credits for a language course plus three credits for cultural immersion/study abroad. Jump start your major, minor or certificate program!

Estimated program costs (as of September 2022): 810 euros (796 US Dollars on October 3, 2022). This cost includes:

- Program registration fee for three weeks
- Cultural excursions (both half-day and day-long excursions)
- Public transportation pass

This cost does not include:

- \$200 MITI course credit transfer fee, paid to University of Cincinnati
- Airfare and ground travel to the campus
- Local lodging on or near the Université Bordeaux Montaigne campus
- Travel insurance
- Passport application fees (if applicable)
- Personal costs and spending money

Scholarships are available for eligible students!

The online application will become available on the UC International website in January 2023. Application deadline: March 2023 (specific date to be determined).
