

Referral Guide and College Information

The College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services will meet with any student/prospective student interested in pursuing a CECH program.

Students interested in transitioning to **CECH**:

- 1. To explore a program offered by CECH, a student should **call 513-556-2336** or **visit 360 Teachers Dyer Complex** to set up an hour-long appointment with the appropriate advisor. During this appointment, students will learn more about CECH and their program(s) of interest; review how their credits may apply towards their intended major; and understand the transition admission requirements.
- 2. Once students attend an advising appointment, they may file the <u>Application for Change in College form</u> located at: http://cech.uc.edu/student-services-center/applications/readmission-or-change-of-college-to-cech.html
- This form and the confirmation form will be accepted until the 5th day of the semester during which a student desires to be admitted to CECH.

- 4. CECH accepts transition students to begin in the fall, spring, or summer semester.

Requirements for transition into CECH Major:

Admission to CECH programs is generally available for students if they were admissible directly from high school and have the **minimum GPA** for the specific program (all prior institutions combined). Students who were NOT admissible from high school must have 24 semester earned and the minimum GPA for the specific program.

Non-CECH Students Interested in Pursuing a CECH Minor or Certificate:

- Applications for the minor should be submitted by the 5th day of the semester in which a student wishes to begin the minor.
- Confirmation of acceptance will be received by the student within two business days of applying, and will

Advising Appointments:

Appointments with CECH advisors are scheduled by the front office staff in 360 Teachers Dyer Complex either in person or by calling (513)556-2336. The College of Education, Criminal Justice, and Human Services will meet with any student/prospective student interested in pursuing a CECH program.

NOTES:

- *Students interested in two tiered admission programs should see a CECH <u>advisor as soon as possible</u>.
- *To be admitted to any Education Cohort, students must also have official documentation of passing scores on the Praxis Core exams or waiver for 22-ACT or 1000-SAT scores. Please check your ACT/SAT for this potential barrier to cohort.
- *For students interested in Sign Language Interpreting, <u>CECH no longer offers this major</u>. The closest college with a similar program is Cincinnati State, which offers an Interpreter Training Program (associate) degree.
- **Students wishing to be <u>holistically reviewed</u> for the CECH IT program, those with significant credit hours and a GPA under a 2.75, should meet with a CECH advisor to discuss this option.
