Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies (WGSS) is an interdisciplinary major that explores the complexity of human experiences and lives. Through a broad range of subjects, WGSS raises questions about gender, race, sexual identity, nationality and social class, focusing particularly on their intersections. WGSS also examines women's roles and achievements historically and cross-culturally. This program of study challenges stereotypes and inequalities, promotes critical thinking and self-awareness and empowers individuals to work for social change.

The UC Department of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies (WGSS) and the UC College of Law offer a joint JD/MA program (the first of its kind in the nation) that provides students an opportunity to engage in rigorous, interdisciplinary, and feminist study of law and social justice.
